

CENTRAL CONTRA COSTA SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY
CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT
WITH RECYCLE REWARDS, INC.

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the Central Contra Costa Solid Waste Authority ("CCCSWA") and RecycleRewards, Inc. ("Consultant"), effective August 1, 2010.

RECITALS

- A. The CCCSWA desires to contract for the provision of professional services for the development and execution of a Residential Recycling Incentive Rewards Program Pilot for the Cities of Moraga and Orinda for a period of 12 months.
- B. Consultant desires to perform such professional services for the CCCSWA.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions contained herein, the CCCSWA and Consultant agree as follows:

AGREEMENTS

- 1. Services. Subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, Consultant shall provide the services as outlined in the Scope of work as outlined in Enclosure A ("Scope of Work")
- 2. Payment.
 - a. Payment for Professional Services. Consultant shall invoice the CCCSWA a total cost not-to-exceed \$102,000.
 - b. Reimbursement of Expenses. The contract amount includes all expenses ordinarily and directly related to the scope of work.
 - c. Additional Services. Any additional services required beyond those set forth in this Agreement shall be performed only if mutually agreed to in writing by the CCCSWA and Consultant and will be pursuant to the rate schedule outlined in the Scope of Work.
- 3. Responsible Personnel. The professional services described in this agreement shall be performed in part and supervised by Axel Newe, Program Manager, and Cameron Thorley, Project Manager. Consultant shall assign only competent personnel to perform services pursuant to this Agreement. In the event that the CCCSWA, at any time during the term of this Agreement, desires the removal of any person or persons assigned by Consultant to perform services pursuant to this Agreement, CCCSWA shall notify Consultant and upon mutual agreement, Consultant shall remove any such person immediately from the CCCSWA.
